Diplomas

- From September 2008 OpenOpportunity will be one of the first partnerships in the country to offer the new **Diplomas** in Construction & The Built Environment and Creative & Media. More will follow in 2009. The Advanced Diploma is worth 3 A levels and graded from A* to E. They are designed to develop skills and experience that employers and universities really value. These will include teamwork and creative thinking and secure and improve your levels of English, maths and ICT. In fact, they give you the skills you need to start a career, or to go to university. The International Baccalaureate [IB]

- Notre Dame High School will be offering the IB Diploma from September 2008 - on behalf of OpenOpportunity.
